Pocket Frog



The Basics

Supplies

Hook: 2.25mm
Yarn: Loops & Threads

Hook: 1.7mm
Yarn: Cotton Fair or Hobbii

Stitches

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
inc = increase
dec = decrease
slst = slip stitch
sp = space
ss = same space
blo = back loop only
flo = front loop only
fo = fasten off

READ THIS!!!

NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make 1 single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note - this comes up.

dec means you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked. Whatever!

All patterns can use a Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring.

I don't care which you use. Just make a hole and commit to it.

| 7) blo sc 30 | 30 |
| 8) [sc 1, dec] x 10 | 20 |
| 9) dec until it's closed enough to fo. | |

NOTE: usually I dec round 9, then fo leaving a little bit of hole in the top. You don't stuff the head and the bottom is arched up inside the head, so no one sees it.

- Stuff a little. It doesn't need much.
16) dec continuously until closed.



Pocket Frog

eyes make 2

- 1) sc 6 in mc 6
- 2) inc 12
- 3-4) sc 12 12
- fo weave ends

lids make 2

- 1) sc 7 in mc 7
- 2) inc 14
- 3-4) sc 14 14
- fo



Put the post eyes in the mc holes. With 1 lid, leave a long tail to sew eye in the lids and to sew the second lid to the first. With the second lid, leave an extra long tail to sew the eyes into the lid, plus to sew both eyes w/ lids to the body.

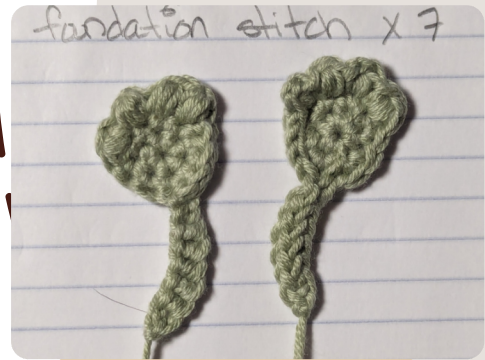
puff: (yo, go into space, yo, pull back through) x3, yo pull through all the loops
ch 1 slst all in the same space.

arms make 2

- 1) sc 6 in mc 6
- 2) slst 2, puffs x 4, slst to center of the bottom of the foot, sc foundation stitch x 5
fo leave long tail for sewing.

legs make 2

- 1) sc 6 in mc 6
- 2) inc 12
- 3) slst 4, puffs x 4, slst to center of the bottom of the foot, sc foundation stitch x 7
fo leave long tail for sewing.



Pocket Frog

Tongue

ch 13
in second ch from hook, dc 1, dc 3, sc in the
rest of the spaces.

Assembly

Place post eyes into the mc of each eye.

Sew eyes on to top of head.

I sew about a 3rd of the head to the body.

Sew the tongue inside the body.

Sew arms about 1 round down from the top of the body, on either side. I usually stick a pin through the body to make sure they're even, but honestly uneven is cute.

The legs, sit the body of a flat surface, make a note of where the body touches the surface and sew the legs right in front at the bottom of the body. If you sew the legs under the body, it tips over.
