# The Basics

### Supplies

Hook: 2.25mm

Yarn: Loops & Threads

OR

Hook: 1.70 Yarn: Cotton Fair

OR

Hook: 1.70

Yarn: Rainbow 8/4 from Hobbii

### Stitches

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

slst = slip stitch

sp = space

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

fo = fasten off

### Notes

Make Eye's First - put eyes in between rounds 6 & 7 before

you stuff the body.

You can also make the arms and legs first and crochet them in as you make the body. The arms go between rounds 7 & 8.

mc = magic circle, magic loop, magic ring or whatever loop you want to make, with or without magic.



### **WARNING:**

Pattern may contain: cuss words, foul language and questionable references.



### **READ THIS!!!**

#### NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make 1 single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note, this will come up. Maybe not in this pattern, but it will come up (:

dec means you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked. Whatever!

All patterns can use a Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring.

I don't care which you use. Just make a hole and commit to it.

1) 6 sc in the mc 6
fo

#### Eye #2

1) 6 sc in mc 6 2) [sc 1 and slst in same space] x6 6 fo

Put posts in eyes and mc of the eyes before stuffing the body.

#### **Body**

#### Horns x2

1) 4 sc in mc 4 2-3) sc 4

NOTE: if sc 4 is to difficult for you, in round 2 do [inc, sc] which will give you 5 sc and then round 3 do sc 5 and fo





#### Arms x2

1) 6 sc in mc	6
2) inc x6	12
3-4) sc 12	12
5) dec x6	6
6) slst x6	6

a) sc into the slst on the opposite side of the stitch marker (or the opposite side from the last slst)

Foundation stitch x5 (If you don't know how to foundation stitch, you can just sc 5.) fo

#### Legs x2

1) 6 sc in mc	6
2) inc x6	12
3-4) sc 12	12
5) dec x6	6
6) slst x6	6

a) sc into the slst on the opposite side of the stitch marker (or the opposite side from the last slst)

Foundation stitch x5 (If you don't know how to foundation stitch, you can just sc 5.) fo

#### **Assembly**

Eye's need to go on to the body before stuffing, between rounds 6 & 7.

Arms are sewn on between rounds 7 & 8.

Legs are sewn on wherever they look good at the bottom. Horns are sewn on round 2.

PIN ON FIRST! Make sure it looks good to you, then sew.
