

1 Pattern Many Dolls



The Basics

Supplies

Hook 2.25

Yarn: Cotton Fair or Hobbii

Stitches

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

slst = slip stitch

sp = space

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

fo = fasten off

Notes

This is the basic base body crochet pattern used to create most basic dolls.

Most patterns are slightly different, but they're all basically the same.

So have fun using this base pattern to make dogs, cats, baby dolls, unicorns and anything else you like.



READ THIS!!!

NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make 1 single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note, this will come up. Maybe not in this pattern, but it will come up (:

NOTE: Not all new pattern designers know this.

WARNING:

Pattern may contain: cuss words, foul language and questionable references.



dec means you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked, Whatever!

mc means: Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring.

I don't care which you use.

Just make a hole and commit
to it

1) 6 sc in mc	6
2) inc x6	12
3) [sc 1, inc] x6	18
4-8) sc 18	18
fo leg 1, don't fo leg 2	

Body

Leg #2 ch 1 - Attach the second leg w/ sc in leg 1 9) sc 18 in the first leg, sc 1 in the ch space, sc 18 in second left and sc 1 in ch space 38

10-16) sc 38	
17) [sc 17, dec] x2	36
18) sc 36	36
19) [sc 10, dec] x3	33
20) sc 33	33
21) [sc 9, dec] x3	30

Place eyes between 34 and 35 or where they look good to you.

Arms x2

1) 6 sc in mc	6
2) inc x6	12
3) [sc 1, inc] x6	18
4-10) sc 18	18
11) fo sc across the top	

Whites of the eyes are 6 sc in an mc, pulled tight around a safety eye before the safety eye is placed in the head.





Kitty Ears x2

1) 4 sc in mc	4
2) inc x4	8
3) [sc 1, inc] x4	12
4) sc 12	12

Puppy Ears x2

1) 6 sc in mc	6
2) inc x6	12
3) [sc 1, inc] x6	18
4) [sc 2, inc] x6	24
5-7) sc 24	24
8) [sc 10, dec] x2	22
9) [sc 7, dec] x2	18
10) [sc 5, dec] x2	14
11-12) sc 14	14

Assembly

Pin arms evenly to each side of the doll, make sure they are even before sewing them on the doll.

Do the same with the ears. Place the ears on the head where they look good to you, pin them on to keep them in place while sewing.

Go wild, sew on hair, make large elephant ears and a trunk or a unicorn horn.
