Izzy Dolls Crochet Pattern

These are not my favorite. There are millions of beautiful crochet doll patterns out there, I don't understand how these became popular. But if this is what you want, here's the pattern.

For the authentic knit look, use the Crochet Knit Stitch, a hook that's two sizes larger than called for, and over stuff so there are plenty of holes.

I used: Hook: 3.25

Yarn: Blush Rainbow

But you can use: Hook: Whatever you want

Yarn: Whatever fits your hook

Lightly stuff as you go.

Hat or Hair Color

1. 6 sc in mc	6
2. inc x6	12
3. (sc 1, inc) x6	18
4. (sc 2, inc) x6	24
5. sc 24	24
6. (sc 3, inc) x6	30
7. sc 30	30
8. (sc 4, inc) x6	36
9-10. sc 36	36

Change to face color

11-19. sc 36 36

Change to shirt color

20-32. sc 36 36

Change to pant color

33-46. sc 36 36

Change to shoe color

47-51. sc 36 36

fo

Finish:

Lightly stuff, then sew the bottom flat or pucker, it's up to you.

Using needle and thread or yarn, weave around neck and pull to make neck - make knot and hide ends.

Sew outline of arms and legs.

sc = single crochet

inc = increase

mc = magic circle

fo = fasten off

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
