These are not my favorite. There are millions of beautiful crochet doll patterns out there, I don't understand how these became popular. But if this is. what you want, here's the pattern.

For the authentic knit look, use the Crochet Knit Stitch, a hook that's two sizes larger than called for, and over stuff so there are plenty of holes.

Lused: Hook: 3.25 Yarn: Blush Rainbow

But you can use: Hook: Whatever you want

Yarn: Whatever fits your hook

Lightly stuff as you go.

Finish:

Lightly stuff, then sew the bottom flat or pucker, it's up to you.

Using needle and thread or yarn, weave around neck and pull to make neck -make knot and hide ends.

Sew outline of arms and legs.



sc = single crochet inc = increase mc = magic circle fo = fasten off
