

Share Anywhere Free Pattern

Owl #2

Hook: 2.75mm

Yarn: Blush Rainbow

NOTE:

1. When placing the eyes, put them on the side of the owl when the stitch marker is on your right (the owls left)
2. Make eyes first
3. Crochet in rounds

Eyes x2

1) 6 sc in mc

2) inc x6 [12]

fo, weave the ends - use the safety eyes to hold them in place.

Alternate eyes

Make 1 eye using the pattern above and the second eye

1) 6 sc in mc

fo, weave the ends - use the safety eyes to hold them in place.

the little one

1. 6 sc in mc

2. inc x6 [12]

3. (sc, inc) x6 [18]

4. (sc 2, inc) x6 [24]

5. BLO sc 24 [24]

6. (sc 2, dec) x6 [18]

7-9. sc 18 [18]

Put eyes between rows 7 & 8

10. (sc, dec) x6 [12]

fo and leave long tail for sewing

Lay the project flat so the eyes are centered on the face and sew up the top.

the medium one

1. 6 sc in mc

2. inc x6 [12]

3. (sc, inc) x6 [18]

4. (sc 2, inc) x6 [24]

5. BLO (sc 3, inc) x6 [30]

6. sc 30 [30]

7. (sc 3, dec) x6 [24]

8-10. sc 24 [24]

Put eyes between rows 9 & 10

11. (sc 2, dec) x6 [18]

12. (sc, dec) x6 [12]

fo and leave long tail for sewing

Lay the project flat so the eyes are centered on the face and sew up the top.

the large one

1. 6 sc in mc

2. inc x6 [12]

3. (sc, inc) x6 [18]

4. (sc 2, inc) x6 [24]

5. BLO (sc 3, inc) x6 [30]

6. (sc 4, inc) x6 [36]

7. (sc 5, inc) x6 [42]

8. sc 42

9. (sc 5, dec) x6 [36]

10-14. sc 36 [36]

Put eyes between rows 12 & 13

15. (sc 4, dec) x6 [30]

16. (sc 3, dec) x6 [24]

17. (sc 2, dec) x6 [18]

fo and leave long tail for sewing

Lay the project flat so the eyes are centered on the face and sew up the top.

Wings x2

1) sc then 8 dc then 1 sc then slst in mc

Pull, but don't make a circle.

slst into the first stitch

fo, leave a long tail for swing.

Beak

Take a length of yellow or orange yarn, folded in half and sew a stitch between the eyes.



sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
inc = increase
dec = decrease
mc = magic circle
fo = fasten off
BLO = back loop only
slst = slip stitch

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
