Abbreviations

Crochet Shorthand:

mc = magic circle

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st = stitch

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

bobble(5 loop) = a 5 loop bobble

sk = skip

fo = fasten off

inc = increase (2 stitches in the same space)

dec = decrease (crochet 2 stitched together)

How to Read Crochet

WARNING:

Pattern may contain: cuss words, foul language and questionable references.

dec means: you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked. Whatever!

mc means: Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring. I don't care which you use. Just make a hole and commit to it.

If several stitches are in the flo of one round, you'll use the blo of those same stitches in the next round.

NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make a single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note, this will come up. Maybe not in this pattern, but it will come up (:

NOTE: Not all new pattern designers know this little crochet fact.



This: **(sc 3, inc) x2, sc 2, dec x2, 3 sc. dc 2**

Means: **sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, dec, dec, sc sc sc, dc, dc**
same space

2. **inc 6** |12

eye on either side

3. **sc 12** |12

4. **sc 12** |12

5. **sc 12** |12

6. **sc 12** |12

7. **sc 12** |12

stuff

8. **dec 6** |6

fo, weave ends
