Share Anywhere Free Pattern Sunflower Ducky Crochet Pattern

Abbreviations

Crochet Shorthand:

mc = magic circle

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st = stitch

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

bobble(5 loop) = a 5 loop bobble

sk = skip

fo = fasten off

inc = increase (2 stitches in the same space)

dec = decrease (crochet 2 stitched together)

() x = repeat

[] = multiple stitches in One Space

How to Read Crochet

WARNING:

Pattern may contain: cuss words, foul language and questionable references.



dec means: you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked. Whatever!

mc means: Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring. I don't care which you use. Just make a hole and commit to it.

If several stitches are in the flo of one round, you'll use the blo of those same stitches in the next round.

NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make a single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note, this will come up. Maybe not in this pattern, but it will come up (:

NOTE: Not all new pattern designers know this little crochet fact.

This **(sc 3, inc) x2, sc 2, dec x2, 3 sc. dc 2**

Means: **sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, dec, dec, sc sc sc, dc, dc**
same space

Pattern:

wing: flo sc, ch 3, sk 1, hdc 2

brown | **yellow** | **orange**

hat:

- 1. **6 sc in mc** |6
- 2. **inc x6** |12
- 3. **(sc, inc) x6** |18
- 4. **(sc, inc, sc) x6** |24
- 5-6. **sc 24** |24
- 7. flo ([slst into next space, ch 2, dc, picot], [dc, ch 2, slst]) x12

NOTE: in case you're questioning it, within the () you are working 2 spaces, within the [] you're working 1 space. See page 2.

fo, weave ends

duckie:

- 7a. **blo sc 24** |24
- 8a. **sc 7, wing, sc 8, wing, sc 7** |24
- eyes between 8 & 9
- 9. **sc 24** |24
- 10. **sc 9, bobble(5 loops), sc 6, bobble(5 loops), sc 7** |24
- 11. **dec x12** |12

stuff

- 12. **dec x6** |6

fo, weave through flo, pull tight to close - weave ends.
