Strawberry Ducky Crochet Pattern



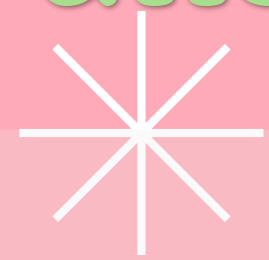
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Abbreviations

Crochet Shorthand:

mc = magic circle

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st = stitch

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

bobble(5 loop) = a 5 loop bobble

sk = skip

fo = fasten off

inc = increase (2 stitches in the same space)

dec = decrease (crochet 2 stitched together)

() x = repeat

[] = multiple stitches in one space



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How to Read Crochet

WARNING:

Pattern may contain: cuss words, foul language and questionable references.

dec means: you can use any kind of decrease you feel comfortable with. Visible, Invisible, Partially visible, Naked. Whatever!

mc means: Magic Circle, Magic Ring, Magic Loop, Ch 2 method or Ch 4 and make a ring. I don't care which you use. Just make a hole and commit to it.

If several stitches are in the flo of one round, you'll use the blo of those same stitches in the next round.

NOTE:

Little known crochet shorthand fact.

sc 3 means make a single crochet in the next 3 spaces.

3 sc means 3 single crochet in the Same Space.

inc x 3 means inc in the next 3 spaces.

Make a mental note, this will come up. Maybe not in this pattern, but it will come up (:

NOTE: Not all new pattern designers know this little crochet fact.



This: (sc 3, inc) x2, sc 2, dec x2, 3 sc, dc 2

Means: sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, sc, inc, sc, sc, dec, dec, sc sc sc, dc, dc
same space



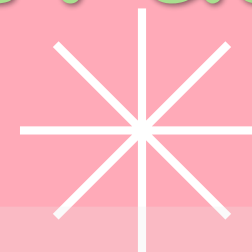
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Yarn: cheap arse fluffy stuff I got off Amazon in wee little skeins or at the local bargain for a buck.

Hook: Usually one size smaller than the yarn you purchased.

Pattern:

wing: flo sc, ch 3, sk 1, hdc 2

red | yellow | orange

hat:

- 1. 6 sc in mc |6
 - 2. inc x6 |12
 - 3. (sc, inc) x6 |18
 - 4. (sc, inc, sc) x6 |24
 - 5-6. sc 24 |24
 - 7. flo (sc 3, inc) x6 |30
 - 8. NOT blo (sc 2, inc, sc 2) x6 |36
- fo, weave ends

ducky:

- 7a. blo sc 24 |24
 - 8a. sc 7, wing, sc 8, wing, sc 7 |24
 - eyes between 8 & 9
 - 9. sc 24 |24
 - 10. sc 9, bobble(5 loops), sc 6, bobble(5 loops), sc 7 |24
 - 11. dec x12 |12
 - stuff
 - 12. dec x6 |6
- fo, weave through flo, pull tight to close - weave ends.



leaf: green

- 1. 6 sc in mc, slst |6
 - 2. (ch 3, sk 1, slst, sc, slst into next space) x6
- fo, leave long tail for sewing on the top of the strawberry

Embroider berry hat with white specs for seeds - see image.

Embroider beak with orange yarn - see image.
